A BILL

To prohibit the Federal Communications Commission from relying on the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in the matter of restoring internet freedom to adopt, amend, revoke, or otherwise modify any rule of the Commission.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Save Net Neutrality
5 Act of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. RULEMAKING IN RELIANCE ON INTERNET FREE-**
2 **DOM NPRM PROHIBITED.**

3 Beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act,
4 the Federal Communications Commission may not rely on
5 the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in the matter of re-
6 storing internet freedom that was adopted by the Commis-
7 sion on May 18, 2017 (FCC 17–60), to satisfy the require-
8 ments of section 553 of title 5, United States Code, for
9 adopting, amending, revoking, or otherwise modifying any
10 rule (as defined in section 551 of such title) of the Com-
11 mission.

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
