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## A BILL

To amend the Agricultural Act of 2014 to require the Secretary of Agriculture to use certain data in determining an actual or benchmark county yield, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. IMPROVEMENTS TO THE AGRICULTURE RISK**  
4 **COVERAGE PROGRAM.**

5 Section 1117(g)(4) of the Agricultural Act of 2014  
6 (7 U.S.C. 9017(g)(4)) is amended to read as follows:

7 “(4) in the case of county coverage—

1           “(A) effective beginning with actual yields  
2           for the 2017 crop year, assign an actual county  
3           yield for each planted acre for the crop year for  
4           the covered commodity—

5                   “(i) for a county for which county  
6                   data collected by the Risk Management  
7                   Agency is sufficient, as determined by the  
8                   Secretary, to offer a county-wide insurance  
9                   product using the actual average county  
10                  yield determined by the Risk Management  
11                  Agency; or

12                  “(ii) for a county not described in  
13                  clause (i) using—

14                   “(I) other sources of yield infor-  
15                   mation (including consultation with  
16                   the applicable State office of the  
17                   Farm Service Agency); or

18                   “(II) the yield history of rep-  
19                   resentative farms in the State, region,  
20                   or crop reporting district, as deter-  
21                   mined by the Secretary;

22           “(B) assign a benchmark county yield for  
23           a crop year using the actual county yield as-  
24           signed in the prior crop year under subpara-  
25           graph (A); and

1                   “(C) make payments, as applicable, to pro-  
2                   ducers using the payment rate of the county of  
3                   the physical location of the base acres of a  
4                   farm.”.

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
