A BILL

To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to exclude the income and assets of dependent students in the calculation of the expected family contribution for such students.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Student Aid Enhance-
5 ment Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CALCULATING EXPECTED FAMILY CONTRIBUTION**
 2 **FOR DEPENDENT STUDENTS.**

3 Part F of title IV of the Higher Education Act of
 4 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1087kk et seq.) is amended—

5 (1) in section 474(b) (20 U.S.C. 1087nn(b))—

6 (A) in paragraph (1)(B), by striking “the
 7 student and”; and

8 (B) in paragraph (4)(B), by striking “and
 9 (B) the student and” and inserting “or (B)”;

10 (2) in section 475 (20 U.S.C. 1087oo)—

11 (A) in subsection (a)—

12 (i) by striking paragraphs (2) and (3);

13 and

14 (ii) by striking “the sum of” and all
 15 that follows through “the parents’ con-
 16 tribution” and inserting “the parents’ con-
 17 tribution”;

18 (B) by striking subsections (g), (h), and
 19 (j); and

20 (C) by redesignating subsection (i) as sub-
 21 section (g); and

22 (3) in section 480(b)(1)(F) (20 U.S.C.
 23 1087vv(b)(1)(F)), by striking “, except” and all that
 24 follows through “parents”.
