1 **SECTION 1. REVISION TO NTAP PERIOD UNDER IPPS AND**
2 **PASS-THROUGH PERIOD UNDER OPPS FOR**
3 **NEW DRUGS AND DEVICES.**

4 (a) REVISION TO NTAP PERIOD UNDER IPPS.—
5 Section 1886(d)(5)(K)(ii)(II) of the Social Security Act
6 (42 U.S.C. 1395ww(d)(5)(K)(ii)(II)) is amended by strik-
7 ing “not less than two years and not more than three
8 years” and inserting “five years”.

9 (b) REVISION TO PASS-THROUGH PERIOD UNDER
10 OPPS.—Section 1833(t)(6) of the Social Security Act (42
11 U.S.C. 1395l(t)(6)) is amended—

12 (1) in subparagraph (B)(iii), by striking “at
13 least 2 years, but not more than 3 years” and in-
14 serting “5 years”; and

15 (2) in subparagraph (C)(i), by striking “at least
16 2 years, but not more than 3 years” and inserting
17 “5 years”.

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
