6	(3) by striking "to fit to the individual" and in-

8	(b) Inclusion in Medical and Other Health
9	Services.—Section 1861(s)(9) of the Social Security Act
10	(42 U.S.C. 1395x(s)(9)) is amended—
11	(1) by striking "leg, arm" and inserting "(A)
12	leg, arm'';
13	(2) in subparagraph (A), as added by para-
14	graph (1), by striking the semicolon at the end and
15	inserting "; and"; and
16	(3) by adding the following new subparagraph:
17	"(B) off-the-shelf orthotics (as defined in
18	section 1847(a)(2)(C)).".
19	(c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
20	this section shall take effect on April 1, 2007, and apply
21	to items and services furnished on or after such date.
