A BILL

To provide for the compensation of Federal contractor employees that may be placed on unpaid leave as a result of the Federal Government shutdown, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Low-Wage Federal
- 5 Contractor Employee Back Pay Act of 2018".

SEC. 2. COMPENSATION FOR FURLOUGHED FEDERAL CON-

- 2 TRACTOR EMPLOYEES.
- 3 Title VII of Division E of the Consolidated Appro-
- 4 priations Act, 2017 (Public Law 115-31) is amended by
- 5 adding at the end the following new section:
- 6 "Sec. 750. If a Federal contractor that provides re-
- 7 tail, food, custodial, or security services to the Federal
- 8 Government places the employees of such contractor on
- 9 unpaid leave as a result of any lapse in appropriations
- 10 which begins in fiscal year 2018, the Government shall
- 11 provide compensation to such employees at their standard
- 12 rate of compensation for the period of such lapse.".
