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## A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to give a public safety and community policing grant preference for applicants prioritizing the hiring of school resource officers, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “School and Student  
5       Safety Act of 2018”.

1 **SEC. 2. PUBLIC SAFETY AND COMMUNITY POLICING GRANT**2 **PREFERENCE FOR APPLICANTS PRIORITIZ-**  
3 **ING THE HIRING OF SCHOOL RESOURCE OF-**  
4 **FICERS.**5 (a) PREFERENCE.—Section 1701(c) of the Omnibus  
6 Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C.  
7 10381(c)) is amended—8 (1) in paragraph (2)(C), by striking “or” after  
9 the semicolon;10 (2) in paragraph (3)(B), by striking the period  
11 at the end and inserting “; or”; and12 (3) by adding at the end the following new  
13 paragraph:14 “(4) from an applicant that prioritizes hiring  
15 new, additional career law enforcement officers for  
16 deployment as school resource officers and individ-  
17 uals for such positions who—

18 “(A) are—

19 “(i) veterans (as defined in section  
20 101 of title 38, United States Code); or21 “(ii) retired law enforcement officers  
22 who—23 “(I) separated from service in  
24 good standing from service with a  
25 public agency as a career law enforce-  
26 ment officer; and

1                         “(II) before such separation,  
2                         served as a career law enforcement of-  
3                         ficer for an aggregate of 10 years or  
4                         more; and

5                         “(B) have not been officially found to be  
6                         unqualified for a position as a career law en-  
7                         forcement officer for reasons relating to mental  
8                         health by a medical professional in a medical  
9                         profession determined by the Attorney General  
10                         to be qualified to make such determinations.”.

11                         (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section  
12 1001(a)(11) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe  
13 Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. 10261(a)(11)) is amend-  
14 ed—

15                         (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking the period  
16                         at the end and inserting “, and such sums as may  
17                         be necessary to carry out part Q for fiscal year 2019  
18                         and each fiscal year thereafter.”; and

19                         (2) in subparagraph (B), in the first sentence  
20                         by striking the period at the end and inserting the  
21                         following: “, and 25 percent shall be made available  
22                         for grants to State and local law enforcement agen-  
23                         cies for the purposes described in section  
24                         1701(b)(12).”.
