Mr. SOTO introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Agriculture, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To increase the access of small farmers in Puerto Rico to Federal agriculture programs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INCREASING THE ACCESS OF SMALL FARMERS**
4 **IN PUERTO RICO WHO GROW SPECIALTY**
5 **CROPS TO FEDERAL AGRICULTURAL LOAN**
6 **PROGRAMS.**

7 The Secretary of Agriculture, through the Office of
8 Advocacy and Outreach, shall increase the access of small
9 farmers who grow specialty crops (as defined in section

1 101 of the Specialty Crops Competitiveness Act of 2004)
2 in Puerto Rico to loans under the following programs:

3 (1) All microloan programs under the Consoli-
4 dated Farm and Rural Development Act.

5 (2) All programs for socially disadvantaged
6 farmers and ranchers under the Consolidated Farm
7 and Rural Development Act.

8 (3) All programs for beginning farmers under
9 the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act.

10 (4) The emergency loan program under subtitle
11 C of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development
12 Act.

13 **SEC. 2. SMALL FARMING ON FEDERAL LANDS.**

14 The Secretary of the Interior shall develop a program
15 to allow small farmers to farm on Federal land in Puerto
16 Rico if the Secretary determines that—

17 (1) the Federal land is not environmentally sen-
18 sitive;

19 (2) farming on the Federal land will not harm
20 endangered native species or natural habitats; and

21 (3) the Federal land is suitable for such farm-
22 ing.

23 **SEC. 3. SMALL FARMER TRAINING PROGRAM.**

24 The Secretary of Agriculture, acting through the Di-
25 rector of the Office of Advocacy and Outreach, shall carry

- 1 out a training program to teach best farming practices
- 2 to small farmers in Puerto Rico.
