- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Reduce Overpre-
- 5 scribing Opioids in Treatment Act of 2018" or the
- 6 "ROOT Act of 2018".

1	SEC. 2. REVISING MEASURES USED UNDER THE HOSPITAL
2	CONSUMER ASSESSMENT OF HEALTHCARE
3	PROVIDERS AND SYSTEMS SURVEY RELAT-
4	ING TO PAIN MANAGEMENT.
5	Section 1886(b)(3)(B)(viii) of the Social Security Act
6	(42 U.S.C. 1395ww(b)(3)(B)(viii)) is amended by adding
7	at the end the following new subclause:
8	"(XII) With respect to the Hospital Consumer As-
9	sessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems survey (or
10	a successor survey), beginning not later than January 1,
11	2020, such survey may not include questions about com-
12	munication by hospital staff with an individual about such
13	individual's pain unless such questions take into account,
14	as applicable, whether an individual experiencing pain was
15	informed about risks associated with the use of opioids
16	and about non-opioid alternatives for the treatment of
17	pain.".

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
