A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to expand access under the Medicare program to addiction treatment in Federally qualified health centers and rural health clinics.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Expanding Access to
- 5 Treatment Act".

1	SEC. 2. EXPANDING ACCESS UNDER THE MEDICARE PRO-
2	GRAM TO ADDICTION TREATMENT IN FEDER-
3	ALLY QUALIFIED HEALTH CENTERS AND
4	RURAL HEALTH CLINICS.
5	(a) Federally Qualified Health Centers.—
6	Section 1834(o) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
7	1395m(o)) is amended by adding at the end the following
8	new paragraph:
9	"(3) Additional payments for certain
10	FQHCS WITH PRACTITIONERS RECEIVING DATA 2000
11	CERTIFICATION.—
12	"(A) IN GENERAL.—In the case of a Fed-
13	erally qualified health center with respect to
14	which, beginning January 1, 2019, Federally-
15	qualified health center services (as defined in
16	section 1861(aa)(3)) are furnished by a health
17	care practitioner who first receives on or after
18	such date a registration or waiver under section
19	303(g) of the Controlled Substances Act to pre-
20	scribe or dispense methadone, buprenorphine,
21	or suboxone for the purpose of maintenance or
22	detoxification treatment, the Secretary shall,
23	subject to availability of funds under subpara-
24	graph (B), make a payment (in accordance with
25	such timing, method, and procedures as speci-
26	fied by the Secretary) to such Federally quali-

1 fied health center in an amount determined by 2 the Secretary, based on an approximation of the 3 cost to receive training for purposes of such registration or waiver, as applicable. For pur-4 poses of the previous sentence, a Federally-6 qualified health center shall apply for a pay-7 ment described in such sentence at such time and in such manner as specified by the Sec-8 9 retary and may apply for such a payment for 10 each practitioner furnishing such services at such center who is described in such sentence.

- "(B) Funding.—For purposes of making payments under this paragraph, there are appropriated, out of amounts in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, \$6,000,000, which shall remain available until expended.".
- 17 (b) RURAL HEALTH CLINIC.—Section 1833 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395l) is amended— 18
- 19 (1) by redesignating the subsection (z) relating 20 to medical review of spinal subluxation services as 21 subsection (aa); and
- 22 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-23 section:

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- 1 "(bb) Additional Payments for Certain Rural
- 2 Health Clinics With Practitioners Receiving
- 3 DATA 2000 CERTIFICATION.—

4 "(1) IN GENERAL.—In the case of a rural 5 health clinic with respect to which, beginning Janu-6 ary 1, 2019, rural health clinic services (as defined 7 in section 1861(aa)(1)) are furnished by a health 8 care practitioner who first receives on or after such 9 date a registration or waiver under section 303(g) of 10 the Controlled Substances Act to prescribe or dis-11 pense methadone, buprenorphine, or suboxone for 12 the purpose of maintenance or detoxification treat-13 ment, the Secretary shall, subject to availability of 14 funds under subparagraph (B), make a payment (in 15 accordance with such timing, method, and proce-16 dures as specified by the Secretary) to such rural 17 health clinic in an amount determined by the Sec-18 retary, based on an approximation of the cost to re-19 ceive training for purposes of such registration or 20 waiver, as applicable. For purposes of the previous 21 sentence, a rural health clinic shall apply for a pay-22 ment described in such sentence at such time and in 23 such manner as specified by the Secretary and may

apply for such a payment for each practitioner fur-

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nishing such services at such clinic who is describedin such sentence.

"(2) Funding.—For purposes of making payments under this subsection, there are appropriated, out of amounts in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, \$2,000,000, which shall remain available until expended.".

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
