5	(a) Annual Reports.—Not less frequently than
6	once each year, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall
7	transmit to each individual employed by the Veterans
8	Health Administration as a physician a report on the
9	opioid prescribing rates of the individual.
10	(b) Pain Management Training.—Each fiscal
11	year, the Secretary shall ensure that each of the individ-
12	uals employed by the Veterans Health Administration as
13	physicians who were among the 10 percent of individuals
14	employed by the Administration as physicians who had the
15	highest opioid prescribing rates in the most recently com-
16	pleted fiscal year receive pain management training.

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
