Mr. CURBELO of Florida (for himself and Mr. SMITH of Nebraska) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To amend title IV–A of the Social Security Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Family Re-
5 sources and Training Options Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. STRENGTHENING PROGRAM INTEGRITY THROUGH**
7 **IMPROPER PAYMENTS REVIEW.**

8 Section 404 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
9 604) is amended by adding at the end the following:

1 “(1) APPLICABILITY OF IMPROPER PAYMENTS
2 LAWS.—

3 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The Improper Payments
4 Information Act of 2002 and the Improper Pay-
5 ments Elimination and Recovery Act of 2010 shall
6 apply to a State in respect of the State program
7 funded under this part in the same manner in which
8 such Acts apply to a Federal agency.

9 “(2) REGULATIONS.—Within 2 years after the
10 date of the enactment of this subsection, the Sec-
11 retary shall prescribe regulations governing how a
12 State reviews and reports improper payments under
13 the State program funded under this part.”.

14 **SEC. 3. SUPPORTING WORK THROUGH CAREER AND TECH-**
15 **NICAL EDUCATION.**

16 Section 407(d)(8) of the Social Security Act (42
17 U.S.C. 607(d)(8)) is amended by striking “(not to exceed
18 12 months with respect to any individual)” inserting “and
19 career and technical education”.

20 **SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

21 The amendments made by this Act shall take effect
22 on October 1, 2018.

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
