A BILL

To disclose the use of Federal funds with any privately held company owned by the President, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Disclosing Official
- 5 Spending at Presidential Businesses Act".

SEC. 2. DISCLOSURE OF EXPENDITURE OF FEDERAL FUNDS

- 3 (a) In General.—The head of each Executive agen-
- 4 cy shall submit a quarterly report to the Director of the
- 5 Office of Government Ethics listing each instance, during
- 6 the most recently ended quarter, that the Executive agen-
- 7 cy obligated or expended Federal funds with any privately
- 8 held company that is owned, either in whole or in part,
- 9 directly or indirectly, including through trusts, by the
- 10 President. With respect to each such instance, the report
- 11 shall include—
- 12 (1) the amount of the obligation or expenditure;
- 13 and
- 14 (2) the name of the company.
- 15 (b) Publication.—Not later than 10 days after re-
- 16 ceiving a report under subsection (a), the Director shall
- 17 publish the report on the Office's public Internet website.
- 18 (c) Definition of Executive Agency.—In this
- 19 section, the term "Executive agency" has the meaning
- 20 given that term in section 105 of title 5, United States
- 21 Code, and includes the United States Postal Service, the
- 22 Postal Regulatory Commission, the White House, and the
- 23 Executive Office of the President.
