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## AN ACT

To amend the Pittman-Robertson Wildlife Restoration Act and the Dingell-Johnson Federal Aid in Sport Fish Restoration Act, to provide parity for United States territories and the District of Columbia, to make technical corrections to such Acts and related laws, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 SECTION 1. APPORTIONMENT UNDER PITTMAN-ROBERT-  
2 SON WILDLIFE RESTORATION ACT.

(a) EQUIVALENT MINIMUM APPORTIONMENT AMONG STATES AND TERRITORIES OF TAX REVENUES ACCRUING TO FUND.—The first subsection (c) of section 4 of the Pittman-Robertson Wildlife Restoration Act (16 U.S.C. 669c), relating to apportionment of certain revenues accruing to the fund, is amended by striking “among the States” and all that follows through the end of the first sentence and inserting: “among the States and each of American Samoa, Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, Puerto Rico, and the United States Virgin Islands in proportion to the ratio that the population of each State and each such territory bears to the population of all the States and such territories, except that each State shall be apportioned not more than 3 percent of such revenues, and each State and each such territory shall be apportioned not less than 1 percent of such revenues.”.

19       (b) APPORTIONMENT OF WILDLIFE CONSERVATION  
20 AND RESTORATION ACCOUNT AMONG TERRITORIES AND  
21 THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA.—The second subsection (c)  
22 of section 4 of the Pittman-Robertson Wildlife Restoration  
23 Act (16 U.S.C. 669c), as added by section 902(e) of H.R.  
24 5548, as introduced in the 106th Congress and enacted  
25 into law by section 1(a)(2) of Public Law 106-55, and  
26 relating to apportionment of the Wildlife Conservation and

1 Restoration Account, is amended by striking paragraph  
2 (1) and inserting the following:

3           “(1) The Secretary of the Interior shall appor-  
4 tion from the Wildlife Conservation and Restoration  
5 Account to each of the District of Columbia, Amer-  
6 ican Samoa, Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands,  
7 Puerto Rico, and the United States Virgin Islands a  
8 sum equal to not more than one-half of 1 percent of  
9 such Account.”.

10          (c) REPEAL OF PERCENTAGE RESTRICTIONS ON AP-  
11 PORTIONMENTS TO TERRITORIES.—Section 8A of the  
12 Pittman-Robertson Wildlife Restoration Act (16 U.S.C.  
13 669g–1) is amended by striking “as he shall determine,  
14 not exceeding” and all that follows through “, in any one  
15 year,” and inserting “as the Secretary shall determine for  
16 each year,”.

17 **SEC. 2. TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO PITTMAN-ROBERT-**  
18 **SON WILDLIFE RESTORATION ACT.**

19          (a) The first section and section 12 of the Pittman-  
20 Robertson Wildlife Restoration Act (16 U.S.C. 669, 669i)  
21 are each amended by striking “Secretary of Agriculture”  
22 each place it appears and inserting “Secretary of the Inte-  
23 rior”.

24          (b) Paragraph (2) of section 3(a) of such Act (16  
25 U.S.C. 669b(a)) is amended—

1                             (1) by moving such paragraph 2 ems to the left;

2                             and

3                             (2) by striking “16 U.S.C. 669(b)(1)” and in-  
4                             serting “subsection (b)(1)”.

5                             (c)(1) Section 4 of such Act (16 U.S.C. 669c) is  
6                             amended by redesignating the second subsection (c) (as  
7                             added by section 902(e) of H.R. 5548, as introduced in  
8                             the 106th Congress and enacted into law by section  
9                             1(a)(2) of Public Law 106–55; relating to apportionment  
10                             of the Wildlife Conservation and Restoration Account) and  
11                             subsection (d) as subsections (d) and (e), respectively.

12                             (2) Section 2(6) of such Act (16 U.S.C. 669a(6)) is  
13                             amended by striking “section 304(d)” and inserting “sec-  
14                             tion 4(e)”.

15                             (3) Section 3(c)(2) of such Act (16 U.S.C.  
16                             669b(c)(2)) is amended by striking “sections 4(d) and (e)  
17                             of this Act,” and inserting “section 4(e),”.

18                             (d) Subsection (d) of section 4 of such Act (16 U.S.C.  
19                             669c), as redesignated by subsection (c)(1) of this section,  
20                             is further amended in paragraph (2)(A)—

21                             (1) in clause (i)—

22                             (A) by striking “one-third of which is  
23                             based” and inserting “One-third of such  
24                             amount shall be apportioned based”; and

(B) by striking “; and” and inserting a period; and

6 (e) Section 6 of such Act (16 U.S.C. 669e) is amend-  
7 ed—

8 (1) in subsection (a)—

18 (C) by inserting “(2)” before “The Sec-  
19 retary of the Interior shall approve”; and

1   **SEC. 3. APPORTIONMENT UNDER DINGELL-JOHNSON**

2                   **SPORT FISH RESTORATION ACT.**

3       Section 12 of the Dingell-Johnson Sport Fish Res-  
4 toration Act (16 U.S.C. 777K) is amended by striking “as  
5 he shall determine, not exceeding for Puerto Rico” and  
6 all that follows through “in any one year, but the Sec-  
7 retary” and inserting “as the Secretary shall determine,  
8 except the Secretary”.

9   **SEC. 4. TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS RELATING TO DINGELL-**

10                   **JOHNSON SPORT FISH RESTORATION ACT.**

11       (a) **CORRECTIONS TO DINGELL-JOHNSON SPORT**  
12 **FISH RESTORATION ACT.**—Section 4(a)(1) of the Dingell-  
13 Johnson Sport Fish Restoration Act (16 U.S.C.  
14 777c(a)(1)) is amended by striking “Protection,” and in-  
15 serting “Protection”.

16       (b) **CORRECTIONS TO RELATED LAWS.**—

17                   (1) Section 111(f)(3) of Public Law 101–593  
18 (16 U.S.C. 777e–1(f)(3)) is amended by striking  
19 “section” and inserting “subsection”.

20                   (2) Section 7404(d)(1) of Public Law 105–178  
21 (16 U.S.C. 777g–1(d)(1)) is amended by striking

1       “section 4(a)(4)” and inserting “section  
2       4(a)(3)(A)”.
