## A BILL

To amend the TRIO programs to require priority to be given to homeless children and youth, and students in foster care.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Foster Youth Success  
5       in College Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. PRIORITY FOR HOMELESS CHILD AND YOUTH AND**  
7       **STUDENTS IN FOSTER CARE.**

8       (a) TALENT SEARCH.—Section 402B(d)(1) of the  
9       Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1070a–  
10      12(d)(1)) is amended by inserting before the semicolon at

1 the end the following: “, and that priority will be given  
2 to homeless children and youth (as such term is defined  
3 in section 725 of the McKinney Vento Homeless Assist-  
4 ance Act (42 U.S.C. 11434a)) and students in foster care  
5 or who are aging out of the foster care system”.

6 (b) UPWARD BOUND.—Section 402C(e)(1) of the  
7 Higher Education Act of 1965 is amended by inserting  
8 before the semicolon at the end the following: “, and that  
9 priority will be given to homeless children and youth (as  
10 such term is defined in section 725 of the McKinney Vento  
11 Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 11434a)) and stu-  
12 dents in foster care or who are aging out of the foster  
13 care system”.
