A BILL

To amend the Controlled Substances Act to provide for enhanced penalties for trafficking in fentanyl, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ENHANCED PENALTIES FOR TRAFFICKING IN**
4 **FENTANYL.**

5 Section 401(b)(1)(B) of the Controlled Substances
6 Act (21 U.S.C. 841(b)(1)(B)) is amended—

7 (1) in clause (vi), by striking “or” at the end;

8 (2) in clause (vii), by striking “or” at the end;

1 (3) in clause (viii), by adding “or” at the end;

2 and

3 (4) by inserting after clause (viii) the following:

4 “(ix) 2 grams or more of a mixture or
5 substance containing a detectable amount
6 of fentanyl, its salts, optical and geometric
7 isomers, and salts of isomers;”.
