A BILL

To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to provide support to State and local governments in their efforts to counter violent extremist threats.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Preventing Radical Ex-
5 tremist’s Violent Endeavors Now and Tomorrow Act of
6 2018” or the “PREVENT Act of 2018”.

1 **SEC. 2. SUPPORT TO STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS IN**
2 **THEIR EFFORTS TO COUNTER VIOLENT EX-**
3 **TREMIST THREATS.**

4 Section 801(b) of the Homeland Security Act of 2002
5 (6 U.S.C. 361(b)) is amended—

6 (1) in paragraph (3), by striking “and” after
7 the semicolon;

8 (2) in paragraph (4), by striking the period at
9 the end and inserting “; and”; and

10 (3) by adding at the end the following new
11 paragraph:

12 “(5) for the purposes of countering violent ex-
13 tremist threats—

14 “(A) provide training from specially
15 trained clinical social workers, psychologists, re-
16 ligious, community leaders, and law enforce-
17 ment personnel, to assist local efforts at secur-
18 ing the homeland; and

19 “(B) in coordination with the Federal Bu-
20 reau of Investigation, provide to State and local
21 governments specialists, analysts, and agents
22 trained to counter terrorism to assist, in the
23 manner and degree necessary, local efforts at
24 responding to such threats.”.

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
