A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to treat the service of Members of the United States Capitol Police who are transferred directly to an administrative or supervisory position with the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center as a law enforcement officer service for purposes of the Federal Employees' Retirement System, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Law Enforcement Re-
3 tirement Enhancement Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. TREATMENT OF SERVICE OF MEMBERS OF THE**
5 **UNITED STATES CAPITOL POLICE WHO**
6 **TRANSFER TO FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT**
7 **TRAINING CENTER AS PRIMARY LAW EN-**
8 **FORCEMENT OFFICER SERVICE FOR PUR-**
9 **POSES OF FEDERAL EMPLOYEES’ RETIRE-**
10 **MENT SYSTEM.**

11 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 8401(17)(C) of title 5,
12 United States Code, is amended by striking the semicolon
13 and inserting the following: “, or an individual who is
14 transferred directly from the Capitol Police to a super-
15 visory or administrative position with the Federal Law
16 Enforcement Training Center after performing service as
17 a member of the Capitol Police for at least 3 years;”.

18 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
19 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to any individual
20 who is transferred directly to a supervisory or administra-
21 tive position with the Federal Law Enforcement Training
22 Center at any time before, on, or after the date of the
23 enactment of this Act, other than any individual who is
24 entitled to an annuity under section 8412(d) of title 5,
25 United States Code, as of the date of the enactment of
26 this Act.

1 (c) DEPOSIT REQUIRED.—An individual described in
2 the amendment made by subsection (a) who transferred
3 directly from the Capitol Police to a supervisory or admin-
4 istrative position with the Federal Law Enforcement
5 Training Center before the date of the enactment of this
6 Act may not receive credit, for purposes of Federal Em-
7 ployees' Retirement System, for service as a law enforce-
8 ment officer (as that term is defined in section 8401(17)
9 of title 5, United States Code) for the period beginning
10 on the date that such individual was so transferred and
11 ending on the date of the enactment of this Act unless
12 such individual pays, in a form and manner as prescribed
13 by the Office of Personnel Management, a deposit equal
14 to the difference between the amount that would have been
15 deducted from the basic pay of the individual under sec-
16 tion 8422 of such title if such individual was, during that
17 period, serving as a law enforcement officer and the
18 amount that was deducted from the basic pay of the indi-
19 vidual under such section during such period, plus interest
20 computed under section 8334(e) of such title.

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
