A BILL

To require the Administrator of the Small Business Administration to establish a pilot program for certifying the status of a small business concern as a small business concern owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Streamlining Small
5 Disadvantaged Businesses Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PILOT PROGRAM TO CERTIFY SMALL BUSINESS**
2 **CONCERNS OWNED AND CONTROLLED BY SO-**
3 **CIALY AND ECONOMICALLY DISADVAN-**
4 **TAGED INDIVIDUALS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 6 months after the
6 date of the enactment of this Act, the Administrator of
7 the Small Business Administration shall establish a pilot
8 program under which a small business concern may apply
9 to the Administrator to be certified as a small business
10 concern owned and controlled by socially and economically
11 disadvantaged individuals. Such system shall—

12 (1) require a small business concern to submit
13 such information as the Administrator shall require;
14 and

15 (2) be made available through a website.

16 (b) USE OF CERTIFICATION.—A certification ob-
17 tained by a small business concern under subsection (a)
18 may be used by a Federal agency, State, or unit of local
19 government to determine whether such concern is a small
20 business concern owned and controlled by socially and eco-
21 nomically disadvantaged individuals.

22 (c) TIMING FOR CERTIFICATION.—The Adminis-
23 trator shall make a determination on the certification of
24 a small business concern as a small business concern
25 owned and controlled by socially and economically dis-

1 advantaged individuals not later than 60 days after receipt
2 of a complete application under subsection (a).

3 (d) TERMINATION.—The pilot program established
4 under this section shall terminate on the date that is 1
5 year after the date of the enactment of this Act.
