Miss GONZÁLEZ-COLÓN of Puerto Rico introduced the following bill; which
was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To designate the José Celso Barbosa Birthplace Home
National Historic Landmark.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. JOSÉ CELSO BARBOSA BIRTHPLACE HOME NA-**
4 **TIONAL LANDMARK.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The Dr. José Celso Barbosa
6 Birthplace Home site (“Casa Natal Dr. José Celso
7 Barbosa”) in Bayamón Puerto Rico, as listed on the Na-
8 tional Register of Historic Places, is hereby designated as
9 the Dr. José Celso Barbosa Home National Historic
10 Landmark.

1 (b) ADMINISTRATION.—Nothing in this section shall
2 affect the administration of the Dr. José Celso Barbosa
3 Birthplace Home by agencies of the Government of Puerto
4 Rico or the City of Bayamón according to their respective
5 jurisdictions.

6 (c) COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS.—The Secretary of
7 the Interior, in consultation with the cultural agencies of
8 the Government of Puerto Rico and the City of Bayamón,
9 may enter into cooperative agreements with public and
10 private entities for the purposes of protecting historic re-
11 sources at the National Historic Landmark and providing
12 educational and interpretive facilities and programs for
13 the public.

14 (d) TECHNICAL AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE.—The
15 Secretary may provide technical and financial assistance
16 to any entity with which the Secretary has entered into
17 a cooperative agreement under subsection (c).

18 (e) NO EFFECT ON PROPERTY RIGHTS.—Designa-
19 tion as a National Historic Landmark shall not prohibit
20 any actions which may otherwise be lawfully taken by the
21 title holders of the site, with respect to their property.

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
