Miss GONZÁLEZ-COLÓN of Puerto Rico introduced the following bill; which
was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To designate the Luis Muñoz Rivera Home National Historic
Landmark.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LUIS MUÑOZ RIVERA HOME NATIONAL LAND-**
4 **MARK.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The Luis Muñoz Rivera Home
6 Museum in Barranquitas, Puerto Rico, as listed on the
7 National Register of Historic Places, is hereby designated
8 as the Luis Muñoz Rivera Home National Historic Land-
9 mark.

10 (b) ADMINISTRATION.—Nothing in this section shall
11 affect the administration of the Luis Muñoz Rivera Home

1 Museum by the cultural agencies of the Government of
2 Puerto Rico or the Municipality of Barranquitas according
3 to their respective jurisdictions.

4 (c) COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS.—The Secretary of
5 the Interior, in consultation with the cultural agencies of
6 the Government of Puerto Rico or the Municipality of
7 Barranquitas, may enter into cooperative agreements with
8 public and private entities for the purposes of protecting
9 historic resources at the National Historic Landmark and
10 providing educational and interpretive facilities and pro-
11 grams for the public.

12 (d) TECHNICAL AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE.—The
13 Secretary may provide technical and financial assistance
14 to any entity with which the Secretary has entered into
15 a cooperative agreement under subsection (c).

16 (e) NO EFFECT ON PROPERTY RIGHTS.—Designa-
17 tion as a National Historic Landmark shall not prohibit
18 any actions which may otherwise be lawfully taken by the
19 title holders of the site, with respect to their property.

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
