Miss GONZÁLEZ-COLÓN of Puerto Rico introduced the following bill; which
was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To designate the Cabezas de San Juan Lighthouse National
Historic Landmark.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CABEZAS DE SAN JUAN LIGHTHOUSE NA-**
4 **TIONAL LANDMARK.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The “Cape San Juan”
6 (“Cabezas de San Juan”) Lighthouse in Fajardo, Puerto
7 Rico, as listed on the National Register of Historic Places,
8 is hereby designated as the Cabezas de San Juan Light-
9 house National Historic Landmark.

1 (b) ADMINISTRATION.—Nothing in this section shall
2 affect the administration of the “Cape San Juan”
3 (“Cabezas de San Juan”) Lighthouse by the Conservation
4 Trust of Puerto Rico, or the respective jurisdictions of
5 agencies of the Government of Puerto Rico or the Municipi-
6 pality of Fajardo.

7 (c) COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS.—The Secretary of
8 the Interior may enter into cooperative agreements with the
9 Conservation Trust of Puerto Rico and the cultural agen-
10 cies of the Government of Puerto Rico or the Municipality
11 of Fajardo, for the purposes of protecting historic re-
12 sources at the National Historic Landmark and providing
13 educational and interpretive facilities and programs for
14 the public.

15 (d) TECHNICAL AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE.—The
16 Secretary may provide technical and financial assistance
17 to any entity with which the Secretary has entered into
18 a cooperative agreement under subsection (c).

19 (e) NO EFFECT ON PROPERTY RIGHTS.—Designa-
20 tion as a National Historic Landmark shall not prohibit
21 any actions which may otherwise be lawfully taken by the
22 title holders of the site, with respect to their property.

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
