 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Reinforced Schools
 - 5 Act".

1	SEC. 2. PROCUREMENT OF EQUIPMENT SUITABLE FOR
2	SCHOOL SECURITY ACTIVITIES.
3	(a) In General.—Section 281 of title 10, United
4	States Code, is amended—
5	(1) in the section heading, by inserting
6	"school security," after "homeland secu-
7	rity,'';
8	(2) by inserting "school security," after "home-
9	land security," each place it appears; and
10	(3) in subsection (d)(2), by adding at the end
11	the following new sentence: "In the case of equip-
12	ment suitable for school security activities, such
13	term includes a local educational agency, public ele-
14	mentary school, and public secondary school (as
15	such terms are defined in section 8101 of the Ele-
16	mentary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20
17	U.S.C. 7801)).".
18	(b) Clerical Amendment.—The table of sections
19	at the beginning of chapter 15 of title 10, United States
20	Code, is amended by striking the item relating to section
21	281 and inserting the following new item:

"281. Procurement of equipment by State and local governments through the Department of Defense: equipment for counter-drug, homeland security, school security, and emergency response activities.".
