A BILL

To direct the Architect of the Capitol to install a commemorative plaque next to each office previously used by a Member of Congress who became President of the United States, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMMEMORATIVE PLAQUE FOR OFFICES PRE-**
4 **VIOUSLY USED BY MEMBERS OF CONGRESS**
5 **WHO BECAME PRESIDENT.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the
7 date of enactment of this Act, the Architect of the Capitol
8 shall design, procure, prepare, and install a plaque de-

1 scribed in subsection (b) for display immediately next to
2 the front door of each office that—

3 (1) is located in a House Office Building or
4 Senate Office Building;

5 (2) was previously used by a Member of Con-
6 gress who became President; and

7 (3) was used as the final individual Member of-
8 fice room of such Member.

9 (b) CONTENTS.—A plaque installed pursuant to sub-
10 section (a) shall—

11 (1) commemorate the use of the office by a
12 Member of Congress who became President; and

13 (2) provide such information about the use of
14 the office as the Architect of the Capitol considers
15 appropriate.

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
