3 Title VII of Division E of the Consolidated Appro4 priations Act, 2018 (Public Law 115–141) is amended by
5 adding at the end the following new section:

6 "SEC. 750. If a Federal contractor that provides re-7 tail, food, custodial, or security services to the Federal 8 Government places the employees of such contractor on 9 unpaid leave as a result of any lapse in appropriations 10 which begins in fiscal year 2019, the Government shall 11 provide compensation to such employees at their standard 12 rate of compensation for the period of such lapse.".
