Ms. EDDIE BERNICE JOHNSON of Texas introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To authorize the President to award the Medal of Honor posthumously to Doris Miller for acts of valor during World War II while a member of the Navy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION FOR AWARD OF MEDAL OF**
4 **HONOR TO DORIS MILLER FOR ACTS OF**
5 **VALOR AS A MEMBER OF THE NAVY DURING**
6 **WORLD WAR II.**

7 Notwithstanding the time limitations specified in sec-
8 tions 6248(a) and 6250 of title 10, United States Code,
9 or any other time limitation with respect to the awarding

1 of certain medals to persons who served in the Armed
2 Forces, the President is authorized to award the Medal
3 of Honor posthumously under section 6241 of such title
4 to Doris Miller (service number 356-12-35) for acts of
5 valor during World War II while a member of the United
6 States Navy.
