Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives regarding the power of Congress to protect the right to vote.

1 Resolved,
2 SECTION 1. PROTECTING THE RIGHT TO VOTE.
3 It is the sense of the House of Representatives that—
4 (1) Congress has the power to prohibit voter
5 suppression activities;
6 (2) in order to increase voter access and participation, Congress should require every State to create

and maintain an online voter registration system

and to automatically register eligible voters whose

information is contained in the State's motor vehicle

- license registration system (with a 21-day opt-out period for those who wish to be taken off the registry); and
- 4 (3) Congress should make Election Day a legal public holiday.
