4 Section 34(a)(1)(B) of the Federal Fire Prevention
5 and Control Act of 1974 (15 U.S.C. 2229a(a)(1)(B)) is
6 amended by inserting “or to change the status of part-
7 time or paid-on-call (as defined in section 33(a)) fire-
8 fighters to full-time firefighters” after “firefighters”.

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
