AN ACT

To amend title XI of the Social Security Act to promote testing of incentive payments for behavioral health providers for adoption and use of certified electronic health record technology.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Improving Access to
3 Behavioral Health Information Technology Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. TESTING OF INCENTIVE PAYMENTS FOR BEHAV-**
5 **IORAL HEALTH PROVIDERS FOR ADOPTION**
6 **AND USE OF CERTIFIED ELECTRONIC**
7 **HEALTH RECORD TECHNOLOGY.**

8 Section 1115A(b)(2)(B) of the Social Security Act
9 (42 U.S.C. 1315a(b)(2)(B)) is amended by adding at the
10 end the following new clause:

11 “(xxv) Providing incentive payments
12 to behavioral health providers for the adop-
13 tion and use of certified electronic health
14 record technology (as defined in section
15 1848(o)(4)) to improve the quality and co-
16 ordination of care through the electronic
17 documentation and exchange of health in-
18 formation. Behavioral health providers may
19 include—

20 “(I) psychiatric hospitals (as de-
21 fined in section 1861(f));

22 “(II) community mental health
23 centers (as defined in section
24 1861(ff)(3)(B));

25 “(III) clinical psychologists (as
26 defined in section 1861(ii));

“(IV) clinical social workers (as defined in section 1861(hh)(1)); and

“(V) hospitals, treatment facilities, and mental health or substance use disorder providers that participate in a State plan under title XIX or a waiver of such plan.”.
