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## A BILL

To protect American job creation by striking the Federal mandate on employers to offer health insurance.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Job Protec-  
5 tion Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROTECT JOB CREATION.**

7 (a) REPEAL OF SHARED RESPONSIBILITY PAYMENT  
8 FOR EMPLOYERS REGARDING HEALTH COVERAGE.—

9 (1) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 43 of the Internal  
10 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking sec-

1       tion 4980H (and the item relating to such section in  
2       the table of sections for such chapter).

3           (2) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 1513  
4       of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act is  
5       amended by striking subsection (c).

6           (3) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made  
7       by this subsection shall apply to months after De-  
8       cember 31, 2016.

9       (b) REPEAL OF REPORTING OF EMPLOYER HEALTH  
10     INSURANCE COVERAGE.—

11           (1) IN GENERAL.—Subpart D of part III of  
12       subchapter A of chapter 61 of the Internal Revenue  
13       Code of 1986 is amended by striking section 6056  
14       (and the item relating to such section in the table  
15       of sections for such subpart).

16           (2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made  
17       by this subsection shall apply to periods beginning  
18       after December 31, 2016.

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
