A BILL

To require a comprehensive plan for the sharing of best practices for depot-level maintenance among the military services.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Department of Defense
5 Depot Maintenance Best Practices Act of 2017”.

6 **SEC. 2. COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR SHARING DEPOT-**
7 **LEVEL MAINTENANCE BEST PRACTICES.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the
9 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense
10 shall submit to the congressional defense committees a

1 comprehensive plan for the sharing of best practices for
2 depot-level maintenance among the military services.

3 (b) ELEMENTS.—The comprehensive plan required
4 under subsection (a) shall cover the sharing of best prac-
5 tices with regard to—

6 (1) programming and scheduling;

7 (2) core capability requirements;

8 (3) workload;

9 (4) personnel management, development, and
10 sustainment;

11 (5) induction, duration, efficiency, and comple-
12 tion metrics;

13 (6) parts, supply, tool, and equipment manage-
14 ment;

15 (7) capital investment and manufacturing and
16 production capability; and

17 (8) inspection and quality control.

18 (c) CONGRESSIONAL DEFENSE COMMITTEES DE-
19 FINED.—In this section, the term “congressional defense
20 committees” has the meaning given the term in section
21 101(a)(16) of title 10, United States Code.

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
