A BILL

To establish a compliance deadline of May 15, 2023, for Step 2 emissions standards for new residential wood heaters, new residential hydronic heaters, and forced-air furnaces.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. STEP 2 COMPLIANCE DEADLINE FOR NEW RESI-**
2 **DENTIAL WOOD HEATERS, NEW RESIDENTIAL**
3 **HYDRONIC HEATERS, AND FORCED-AIR FUR-**
4 **NACES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—With respect to the final rule enti-
6 tled “Standards of Performance for New Residential
7 Wood Heaters, New Residential Hydronic Heaters and
8 Forced-Air Furnaces” (80 Fed. Reg. 13672 (March 16,
9 2015)), the compliance deadline for Step 2 emissions
10 standards shall be May 15, 2023.

11 (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING CHANGES.—Not
12 later than 60 days after the date of enactment of this Act,
13 the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agen-
14 cy shall finalize such technical and conforming changes to
15 rules and guidance documents as may be necessary to im-
16 plement subsection (a).

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
