A BILL

To repeal the Protection of Lawful Commerce in Arms Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Equal Access to Jus-
5 tice for Victims of Gun Violence Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF THE PROTECTION OF LAWFUL COM-**
2 **MERCE IN ARMS ACT.**

3 Sections 2, 3, and 4 of the Protection of Lawful Com-
4 merce in Arms Act (15 U.S.C. 7901, 7902, and 7903)
5 are repealed.

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
