A BILL

To designate the wilderness within the Lake Clark National Park and Preserve in the State of Alaska as the Jay S. Hammond Wilderness Area.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Jay S. Hammond Wil-
5 derness Act of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF JAY S. HAMMOND WILDERNESS**

2 **AREA.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The approximately 2,600,000
4 acres of National Wilderness Preservation System land lo-
5 cated within the Lake Clark National Park and Preserve
6 designated by section 201(e)(7)(a) of the Alaska National
7 Interest Lands Conservation Act (16 U.S.C.
8 410hh(e)(7)(a)) shall be known and designated as the
9 “Jay S. Hammond Wilderness Area”.

10 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
11 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
12 States to the wilderness area referred to in subsection (a)
13 shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Jay S. Ham-
14 mond Wilderness Area”.

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
