A BILL

To require mailing addresses to correspond with the physical address at which the mail will be delivered.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MAILING ADDRESS REQUIREMENTS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter VI of chapter 36 of
5 title 39, United States Code, is amended by adding at the
6 end the following:

7 **“§ 3687. Mailing address requirements**

8 “(a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—

9 “(1) the term ‘municipality’ means a city, town,
10 borough, county, parish, district, association, or

1 other public entity established by, or pursuant to,
 2 applicable State law; and

3 “(2) the term ‘State’ means each of the several
 4 States, territories, and possessions of the United
 5 States, the District of Columbia, and the Common-
 6 wealth of Puerto Rico.

7 “(b) PHYSICAL AND MAILING ADDRESS SHALL COR-
 8 RESPOND.—The State and municipality used by the Post-
 9 al Service for the delivery address for purposes of mail
 10 matter shall correspond with the State and municipality
 11 of the physical address of the location for the delivery of
 12 such mail matter.”.

13 (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—
 14 The table of sections for chapter 36 of title 39, United
 15 States Code, is amended by inserting after the item relat-
 16 ing to section 3686 the following:

“3687. Mailing address requirements.”.
