- 3 SECTION 1. MAILING ADDRESS REQUIREMENTS.
- 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter VI of chapter 36 of
- 5 title 39, United States Code, is amended by adding at the
- 6 end the following:
- 7 "§ 3687. Mailing address requirements
- 8 "(a) Definitions.—In this section—
- 9 "(1) the term 'municipality' means a city, town,
- borough, county, parish, district, association, or

- 1 other public entity established by, or pursuant to,
- 2 applicable State law; and
- 3 "(2) the term 'State' means each of the several
- 4 States, territories, and possessions of the United
- 5 States, the District of Columbia, and the Common-
- 6 wealth of Puerto Rico.
- 7 "(b) Physical and Mailing Address Shall Cor-
- 8 RESPOND.—The State and municipality used by the Post-
- 9 al Service for the delivery address for purposes of mail
- 10 matter shall correspond with the State and municipality
- 11 of the physical address of the location for the delivery of
- 12 such mail matter.".
- 13 (b) Technical and Conforming Amendment.—
- 14 The table of sections for chapter 36 of title 39, United
- 15 States Code, is amended by inserting after the item relat-
- 16 ing to section 3686 the following:

"3687. Mailing address requirements.".
