- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS FOR VETERANS
- 4 BENEFITS AND SERVICES.
- 5 There are hereby appropriated for fiscal year 2018,
- 6 out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appro-
- 7 priated, for any period during which interim or full-year
- 8 appropriations for fiscal year 2018 are not in effect, such
- 9 sums as are necessary to administer and provide benefits
- 10 and services to veterans, dependents, and survivors pro-

- 1 vided under chapters 11, 13, 15, 18, 21, 23, 30, 31, 33,
- 2 35, and 39 of title 38, United States Code.

3 SEC. 2. TERMINATION.

- 4 Appropriations and funds made available and author-
- 5 ity granted pursuant to this Act shall be available until
- 6 whichever of the following first occurs:
- 7 (1) The enactment into law of an appropriation
- 8 (including a continuing appropriation) for any pur-
- 9 pose for which amounts are made available in sec-
- 10 tion 1.
- 11 (2) The enactment into law of the applicable
- 12 regular or continuing appropriations resolution or
- other Act without any appropriation for such pur-
- pose.
- 15 (3) January 1, 2019.
