Mr. HELLER introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To transfer administrative jurisdiction over certain Bureau of Land Management land from the Secretary of the Interior to the Secretary of Veterans Affairs for use as a national cemetery, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Elko National Ceme-

5 ter Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

7 In this Act:

1 (1) FEDERAL LAND.—The term “Federal land”
2 means the approximately 15 acres of Bureau of
3 Land Management land in Elko, Nevada, that is
4 more particularly described as T. 34 N., R. 55 E.,
5 sec. 8 NW, and is identified as “Parcels 1–6” on the
6 map entitled “T. 34 N., R. 55 E., Section 8 NW”.

7 (2) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
8 the Secretary of the Interior.

9 **SEC. 3. TRANSFER AND WITHDRAWAL OF BUREAU OF LAND**

10 **MANAGEMENT LAND FOR USE AS A NA-**
11 **TIONAL CEMETERY.**

12 (a) TRANSFER OF ADMINISTRATIVE JURISDIC-
13 TION.—

14 (1) IN GENERAL.—Subject to valid existing
15 rights, administrative jurisdiction over the Federal
16 land is transferred from the Secretary to the Sec-
17 retary of Veterans Affairs for use as a national cem-
18 etery in accordance with chapter 24 of title 38,
19 United States Code.

20 (2) LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS.—

21 (A) IN GENERAL.—As soon as practicable
22 after the date of enactment of this Act, the Sec-
23 retary shall publish in the Federal Register a
24 notice containing a legal description of the Fed-
25 eral land.

14 tration.

20 (b) WITHDRAWAL.—Subject to valid existing rights,
21 for any period during which the Federal land is under the
22 administrative jurisdiction of the Secretary of Veterans
23 Affairs, the Federal land—

1 laws, the mineral leasing laws, and the geothermal
2 leasing laws; and

3 (2) shall be treated as property (as defined in
4 section 102 of title 40, United States Code).
