### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Coastal Texas Protec-

5 tion Act".

### 6 SEC. 2. COASTAL TEXAS PROTECTION AND RESTORATION.

7 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-8 retary of the Army shall expedite the completion of feasi-

bility studies for flood damage reduction, hurricane and
 storm damage reduction, and ecosystem restoration in the
 coastal areas of Texas that are identified in the interim
 report due to be published in 2018 that describes the ten tatively selected plan developed in accordance with section
 4091 of the Water Resources Development Act of 2007
 (121 Stat. 1187).
