**A BILL**

To amend the National Trails System Act to provide for  
the study of the Pike National Historic Trail.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Pike National Historic  
5       Trail Study Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. WESTERN STATES TRAIL STUDY.**

2 Section 5(c) of the National Trails System Act (16  
3 U.S.C. 1244(c)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
4 lowing:

5 “(46) PIKE NATIONAL HISTORIC TRAIL.—The  
6 Pike National Historic Trail, a series of routes ex-  
7 tending approximately 3,664 miles, which follows the  
8 route taken by Lt. Zebulon Montgomery Pike during  
9 the 1806–1807 Pike expedition that began in Fort  
10 Bellefontaine, Missouri, extended through portions  
11 of the States of Kansas, Nebraska, Colorado, New  
12 Mexico, and Texas, and ended in Natchitoches, Lou-  
13 isiana.”.



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
