Mr. MENENDEZ introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs

A BILL

To ban the exportation of crude oil or refined petroleum products derived from Federal land, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Oil for
5 American Families Act of 2018”.

6 **SEC. 2. BAN ON EXPORTING CRUDE OIL OR REFINED PE-**
7 **TROLEUM PRODUCTS DERIVED FROM FED-**
8 **ERAL LAND.**

9 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

1 (1) PETROLEUM PRODUCT.—The term “petro-
2 leum product” means any of the following:

3 (A) Finished reformulated or conventional
4 motor gasoline.

5 (B) Finished aviation gasoline.

6 (C) Kerosene-type jet fuel.

7 (D) Kerosene.

8 (E) Distillate fuel oil.

9 (F) Residual fuel oil.

10 (G) Lubricants.

11 (H) Waxes.

12 (I) Petroleum coke.

13 (J) Asphalt and road oil.

14 (2) PUBLIC LAND.—

15 (A) IN GENERAL.—The term “public land”
16 means any land and interest in land owned by
17 the United States within the several States and
18 administered by the Secretary concerned, with-
19 out regard to how the United States acquired
20 ownership.

21 (B) INCLUSION.—The term “public land”
22 includes land on the outer Continental Shelf.

23 (3) SECRETARY CONCERNED.—The term “Sec-
24 retary concerned” means—

1 (A) the Secretary of Agriculture (acting
2 through the Chief of the Forest Service), with
3 respect to National Forest System land; and

4 (B) the Secretary of the Interior, with re-
5 spect to land managed by—

6 (i) the Bureau of Land Management
7 (including land held for the benefit of an
8 Indian tribe);

9 (ii) the National Park Service;

10 (iii) the Bureau of Ocean Energy
11 Management; and

12 (iv) the United States Fish and Wild-
13 life Service.

14 (b) BAN.—Notwithstanding any other provision of
15 law, petroleum extracted from public land, or a petroleum
16 product produced from the petroleum extracted from pub-
17 lic land, may not be exported from the United States.
