Mr. ROUNDS introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred  
to the Committee on Armed Services

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## A BILL

To require USTRANSCOM assessments of transportation  
infrastructure.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “United States Trans-  
5 portation Command Infrastructure Assessment Act of  
6 2018”.

7 **SEC. 2. UNITED STATES TRANSPORTATION COMMAND AS-**  
8 **SESSMENTS OF TRANSPORTATION INFRA-**  
9 **STRUCTURE.**

10 (a) RESPONSIBILITIES.—In coordination with the  
11 Secretary of Transportation, the Commander of the

1 United States Transportation Command shall make avail-  
2 able to the appropriate congressional committees a de-  
3 scription and assessment of the condition of the defense  
4 transportation sector functions, systems, assets, and de-  
5 pendencies as they relate to supporting Department of De-  
6 fense operational capabilities and assets, including any re-  
7 lated Transportation Engineering Agency Infrastructure  
8 Assessments.

9 (b) IDENTIFICATION OF RESOURCE REQUIRE-  
10 MENTS.—In coordination with the Secretary of Transpor-  
11 tation, the Commander shall identify and submit to the  
12 appropriate congressional committees consolidated and  
13 prioritized resource requirements for transportation infra-  
14 structure at the same time the President submits to Con-  
15 gress the budget for the next fiscal year under section  
16 1105 of title 31, United States Code. The submission from  
17 the Commander shall include a synopsis of the En Route  
18 Infrastructure Master Plan and other information nec-  
19 essary to provide a single source comprehensive set of re-  
20 source requirements for transportation infrastructure.

21 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section, the term “appro-  
22 priate congressional committees” means—

23 (1) the Committee on Armed Services, the  
24 Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transpor-

1       tation, and the Committee on Appropriations of the  
2       Senate; and

3               (2) the Committee on Armed Services, the  
4       Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure,  
5       and the Committee on Appropriations of the House  
6       of Representatives.

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
