A BILL

To amend the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006 to require a State to conduct State leadership activities that reduce or eliminate out-of-pocket expenses related to enrollment in a career and technical education course or dual or concurrent enrollment program for students in special populations.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Free Career and Tech-
5 nical Education for High School Students Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. STATE LEADERSHIP ACTIVITIES.**

2 Section 124(b) of the Carl D. Perkins Career and
3 Technical Education Act of 2006 (20 U.S.C. 2344(b)) is
4 amended—

5 (1) in paragraph (8), by striking “and” at the
6 end;

7 (2) in paragraph (9), by striking the period and
8 inserting “; and”; and

9 (3) by adding at the end the following:

10 “(10)(A) reducing or eliminating out-of-pocket
11 expenses for special populations participating in ca-
12 reer and technical education, including dual enroll-
13 ment or early college high school programs; and

14 “(B) supporting the costs for special popu-
15 lations associated with fees, transportation, child
16 care, or mobility challenges relating to such partici-
17 pation.”.

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
