To amend title 38, United States Code, to modify the requirements for applications for construction of State home facilities to increase the maximum percentage of nonveterans allowed to be treated at such facilities, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. MODIFICATION OF REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLI-**
2 **CATIONS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF STATE**
3 **HOME FACILITIES TO INCREASE THE MAX-**
4 **IMUM PERCENTAGE OF NONVETERANS**
5 **TREATED.**

6 Section 8135(a)(4) of title 38, United States Code,
7 is amended—

8 (1) by striking “Reasonable assurance” and in-
9 serting “(A) Reasonable assurance”;

10 (2) by inserting “, except as provided in sub-
11 paragraph (B),” after “and that”; and

12 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
13 paragraph:

14 “(B) Reasonable assurance that, for purposes
15 of providing care to spouses of veterans, during a
16 period in which a facility is operating with a bed oc-
17 cupancy rate of 90 percent or less, not more than
18 40 percent of the bed occupancy at any one time will
19 consist of patients who are not receiving such level
20 of care as veterans.”.

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
