A BILL

To amend the Forest and Rangeland Renewable Resources Planning Act of 1974 to modify a provision relating to certain consultation requirements.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NO ADDITIONAL CONSULTATION REQUIRED**
4 **WITH RESPECT TO CERTAIN NEW INFORMA-**
5 **TION.**

6 Section 6(d)(2) of the Forest and Rangeland Renew-
7 able Resources Planning Act of 1974 (16 U.S.C.
8 1604(d)(2)) is amended—

9 (1) in subparagraph (A)—

1 (A) in clause (i), by striking “and” at the
2 end;

3 (B) in clause (ii), by striking the period at
4 the end and inserting “; or”; and

5 (C) by adding at the end the following:

6 “(iii) any new information (within the
7 meaning of subsection (b) of section
8 402.16 of title 50, Code of Federal Regula-
9 tions (or a successor regulation)) relating
10 to a land management plan, if the land
11 management plan has been adopted by the
12 Secretary as of the date on which the new
13 information is revealed.”; and

14 (2) in subparagraph (B)(ii)—

15 (A) by striking “since the date” and in-
16 serting the following: “since the later of—

17 “(I) the date”;

18 (B) in subclause (I) (as so designated), by
19 striking “this section or the date” and inserting
20 the following: “this section; and

21 “(II) as applicable—

22 “(aa) the date”; and

23 (C) in subclause (II)(aa) (as so des-
24 ignated), by striking “subparagraph, whichever

1 is later.” and inserting the following: “subpara-
2 graph; or

3 “(bb) the date on which new
4 information relating to the land
5 management plan is revealed as
6 described in clause (iii) of that
7 subparagraph.”.

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
