1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Funding for Aviation
3 Screeners and Threat Elimination Restoration Act” or the
4 “FASTER Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF REQUIREMENT REGARDING CREDITING**
6 **AND DEPOSIT OF A PORTION OF AVIATION**
7 **SECURITY FEES.**

8 (a) REPEAL.—Subsection (i) of section 44940 of title
9 49, United States Code, is repealed.

10 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Subsection (d)(4)
11 of such section is amended by striking “, other than sub-
12 section (i),”.

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
