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## A BILL

To amend section 520E of the Public Health Service Act to require States and their designees receiving grants for development and implementation of statewide suicide early intervention and prevention strategies to collaborate with each Federally recognized Indian tribe, tribal organization, urban Indian organization, and Native Hawaiian health care system in the State.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1   **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “Native American Sui-  
3   cide Prevention Act of 2018”.

4   **SEC. 2. COLLABORATION WITH FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED**  
5                   **INDIAN TRIBES, TRIBAL ORGANIZATIONS,**  
6                   **URBAN INDIAN ORGANIZATIONS, AND NATIVE**  
7                   **HAWAIIAN HEALTH CARE SYSTEMS IN DEVEL-**  
8                   **OPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF STATE-**  
9                   **WIDE SUICIDE EARLY INTERVENTION AND**  
10                  **PREVENTION STRATEGIES.**

11       Subsection (e) of section 520E of the Public Health  
12   Service Act (42 U.S.C. 290bb–36) is amended by adding  
13   at the end the following:

14                  “(4) COLLABORATION WITH FEDERALLY RE-  
15   COGNIZED INDIAN TRIBES, TRIBAL ORGANIZATIONS,  
16   URBAN INDIAN ORGANIZATIONS, AND NATIVE HA-  
17   WAIIAN HEALTH CARE SYSTEMS.—As a condition on  
18   the receipt of a grant or cooperative agreement  
19   under this section for development and implementa-  
20   tion of a statewide early intervention and prevention  
21   strategy, a State or an eligible entity designated by  
22   a State pursuant to subsection (b)(1)(B) shall agree  
23   to collaborate with each Federally recognized Indian  
24   tribe and tribal organization (as defined in the In-  
25   dian Self-Determination and Education Assistance  
26   Act), each urban Indian organization (as defined in

1       the Indian Health Care Improvement Act), and each  
2       Native Hawaiian health care system (as defined in  
3       section 12 of the Native Hawaiian Health Care Im-  
4       provement Act) in the State regarding such develop-  
5       ment and implementation.”.
