## A BILL

To require Executive agencies to make public all funding reprogramming requests, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

**3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.** 

4 This Act may be cited as the "Transparency in Fed-5 eral Spending Act of 2018".

6 SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT TO NOTIFY REGARDING RE-7PROGRAMMING AND TRANSFER OF FUNDS.

8 (a) DEFINITION OF EXECUTIVE AGENCY.—In this9 section, the term "Executive agency" has the meaning

given the term in section 105 of title 5, United States
 Code.

3 (b) REQUIREMENT.—If an Executive agency requests
4 a reprogramming of funds or uses authority available to
5 the Executive agency to reprogram or transfer funds, the
6 Executive agency shall—

7 (1) concurrently post on the website of the Ex8 ecutive agency a notice of the request, reprogram9 ming, or transfer; and

(2) if the request, reprogramming, or transfer
is for an amount that is not less than \$5,000,000,
concurrently notify each member of the Committees
on Appropriations of the Senate and the House of
Representatives.

(c) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this section shall be construed to supersede or otherwise alter any
other provision of Federal law that imposes notification
or other requirements relating to the reprogramming or
transfer of funds by Executive agencies.

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
