Mr. KENNEDY introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Environment and Public Works

A BILL

To provide for certain water resources development activities of the Corps of Engineers, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.**

4 In this Act:

5 (1) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
6 the Secretary of the Army.

7 (2) STATE.—The term “State” means the State
8 of Louisiana.

1 **SEC. 2. CREDIT FOR WORK PERFORMED BY THE STATE.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—On request of the State, the Sec-
3 retary shall credit any work performed or to be performed
4 by the State that is part of the comprehensive coastal pro-
5 tection master plan described in section 7002(c) of the
6 Water Resources Development Act of 2007 (121 Stat.
7 1271; 128 Stat. 1319) as an offset against any out-
8 standing or future cost-share obligation of the State under
9 the Greater New Orleans Hurricane and Storm Damage
10 Risk Reduction System.

11 (b) REQUIREMENTS.—The State shall describe in
12 each request under subsection (a)—

13 (1) the work performed or to be performed by
14 the State for which the credit is requested;

15 (2) the amount of the requested credit;

16 (3) the 1 or more projects authorized under
17 title VII of the Water Resources Development Act of
18 2007 (121 Stat. 1270) that the State proposes to
19 deauthorize in exchange for a credit under sub-
20 section (a); and

21 (4) the date on which the work performed was
22 completed or the scheduled date of completion of the
23 work to be performed, as applicable.

24 (c) CREDIT LIMITATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS.—

1 (1) PER REQUEST.—The Secretary shall ensure
2 that the total amount of the credit provided to the
3 State for each request—

4 (A) is equal to the cost of the work per-
5 formed or to be performed by the State; but

6 (B) does not exceed the Federal share of
7 the cost of the 1 or more projects identified
8 under subsection (b)(3) for that request.

9 (2) TOTAL LIMITATION.—The total amount of
10 credit provided to the State under this section may
11 not exceed the Federal share of the cost of the
12 projects authorized under title VII of the Water Re-
13 sources Development Act of 2007 (121 Stat. 1270)
14 as authorized.

15 (3) DEAUTHORIZED PROJECTS.—A project list-
16 ed in a request under subsection (b)(3) may be a de-
17 authorized project, if that deauthorized project was
18 deauthorized before the date that is 1 year after the
19 date of enactment of this Act.

20 (d) DEAUTHORIZATION.—

21 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after
22 the date on which the Secretary receives a request
23 under subsection (a), the Secretary shall submit to
24 Congress a copy of the request, including any pro-
25 posed deauthorization under subsection (b)(3).

1 (2) CONGRESSIONAL REVIEW.—After the expi-
2 ration of the 180-day period beginning on the date
3 on which the request is submitted to Congress under
4 paragraph (1), the project proposed to be deauthor-
5 ized shall be deauthorized, unless Congress passes a
6 joint resolution disapproving the deauthorization be-
7 fore the end of that period.

8 **SEC. 3. SENSE OF CONGRESS RELATING TO PORT OF IBE-**
9 **RIA NAVIGATION PROJECT.**

10 It is the sense of Congress that—

11 (1) the project for navigation, Port of Iberia,
12 Louisiana, authorized by section 1001(25) of the
13 Water Resources Development Act of 2007 (121
14 Stat. 1053; 128 Stat. 1351) is valuable; and

15 (2) not later than 180 days after the date of
16 enactment of this Act, the Corps of Engineers
17 should expeditiously complete the post-authorization
18 change report for the project described in paragraph
19 (1).

20 **SEC. 4. SENSE OF CONGRESS RELATING TO CERTAIN**
21 **FLOOD PROTECTION PROJECTS, JEAN LA-**
22 **FITTE, LOUISIANA.**

23 It is the sense of Congress that—

24 (1) ongoing cooperation between the Louisiana
25 Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority and

1 the Lafitte Area Independent Levee District relating
2 to flood protection projects in Jean Lafitte, Lou-
3 isiana, and the vicinity should continue; and

4 (2) to the maximum extent practicable, the Sec-
5 retary should support that cooperation in a manner
6 that is consistent with Louisiana's Comprehensive
7 Master Plan for a Sustainable Coast.

8 **SEC. 5. RED RIVER BELOW DENISON DAM, ARKANSAS, LOU-**
9 **ISIANA, AND TEXAS.**

10 The Secretary shall—

11 (1) review whether the project for flood control,
12 Red River below Denison Dam, Arkansas, Lou-
13 isiana, and Texas, authorized by section 10 of the
14 Flood Control Act of 1946 (60 Stat. 647, chapter
15 596) should be modified to incorporate the Cherokee
16 Park Levee, Caddo Parish, Louisiana;

17 (2) determine whether to include the modifica-
18 tion in the report submitted to Congress pursuant to
19 section 7001 of the Water Resources Reform and
20 Development Act of 2014 (33 U.S.C. 2282d); and

21 (3) if the Secretary determines to include the
22 modification as described in paragraph (2), submit
23 to Congress a notification of that determination.
