Mr. PERDUE (for himself and Mr. PETERS) introduced the following bill;
which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to carry out a pilot program to provide access to magnetic EEG/EKG-guided resonance therapy to veterans.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Hero Left Un-
5 treated Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

7 Congress finds the following:

8 (1) Magnetic EEG/EKG-guided resonance ther-
9 apy has successfully treated more than 400 veterans

1 with post-traumatic stress disorder, traumatic brain
2 injury, military sexual trauma, chronic pain, and
3 opiate addiction.

4 (2) Recent clinical trials and randomized, pla-
5 cebo-controlled, double-blind studies have produced
6 promising measurable outcomes in the evolution of
7 magnetic EEG/EKG-guided resonance therapy.

8 (3) The outcomes described in paragraph (2)
9 have resulted in escalating demand from returning
10 members of the Armed Forces and veterans who are
11 seeking access to magnetic EEG/EKG-guided reso-
12 nance therapy.

13 (4) Congress recognizes the importance of initi-
14 ating innovative pilot programs that demonstrate the
15 use and effectiveness of new treatment options for
16 post-traumatic stress disorder, traumatic brain in-
17 jury, military sexual trauma, chronic pain, and opi-
18 ate addiction.

19 **SEC. 3. MAGNETIC EEG/EKG-GUIDED RESONANCE THERAPY**
20 **PILOT PROGRAM.**

21 (a) PILOT PROGRAM.—Commencing not later than
22 90 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
23 Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall carry out a pilot pro-
24 gram to provide access to magnetic EEG/EKG-guided res-
25 onance therapy to treat veterans suffering from post-trau-

1 matic stress disorder, traumatic brain injury, military sex-
2 ual trauma, chronic pain, or opiate addiction.

3 (b) LOCATIONS.—The Secretary shall carry out the
4 pilot program under subsection (a) at not more than two
5 facilities of the Department of Veterans Affairs.

6 (c) PARTICIPANTS.—In carrying out the pilot pro-
7 gram under subsection (a), the Secretary shall provide ac-
8 cess to magnetic EEG/EKG-guided resonance therapy to
9 not more than 50 veterans.

10 (d) DURATION.—The Secretary shall carry out the
11 pilot program under subsection (a) for a one-year period.

12 (e) REPORT.—Not later than 90 days after the termi-
13 nation of the pilot program under subsection (d), the Sec-
14 retary shall submit to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs
15 of the Senate and the Committee on Veterans' Affairs of
16 the House of Representatives a report on the pilot pro-
17 gram.

18 (f) NO AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—No
19 additional amounts are authorized to be appropriated to
20 carry out the requirements of this section. Such require-
21 ments shall be carried out using amounts authorized
22 under provisions of law other than this section.

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
